Pontefract Collieries Academy


Pontefract Collieries Football Academy strives to enable students, passionate about football, to develop their skills whilst gaining valuable complementary academic qualifications.

The alliance aims to achieve the highest standard of delivery for all learners by placing them at the centre. The alliance also aspires to motivate candidates, build confidence, inspire dreams and nurture talent; building a solid foundation for a strong and vibrant local economy through education and UEFA standard coaching.

Pontefract Collieries Club currently plays in the Northern Premier League, North/West Division and the academy has links with other professional clubs such as Leeds United, Barnsley F.C., Doncaster Rovers and Hull City.

Read School offers:

- A-Level PE or BTEC Sport with high-quality teaching in small class sizes.
- Opportunities to represent the school in football against other local and independent schools.
- Opportunities to develop coaching skills in-house, supporting younger players.
- Spacious accommodation in the boarding house on the Read School site in Drax, near Selby, with all meals, laundry and transportation included.
- Mentoring and support in all future university or apprenticeship applications.
- Tier 4 or 5 study visa sponsorship.
- Additional English support, if required.
- Three training sessions per week with an UEFA-licensed coach both at Read School where we recently installed £20k worth of LED floodlighting (18 lights) around two pitches & at Pontefract Collieries' with access to a top, state-of-the-art 4G training facility.
- Fixtures as part of the academy in the Youth Alliance League on a Wednesday afternoon, with home fixtures taking place at the Pontefract Collieries' Regional Electrical Services Stadium (RESS).
- Opportunities for talented players to be placed within various levels of the football pyramid by the club.
- Regular strength and conditioning sessions drawing on latest research and thinking.
- Opportunities to further develop coaching skills at both Pontefract Collieries and Read School.
- Regular bespoke reviews and feedback from staff team and other visiting industry professionals.
